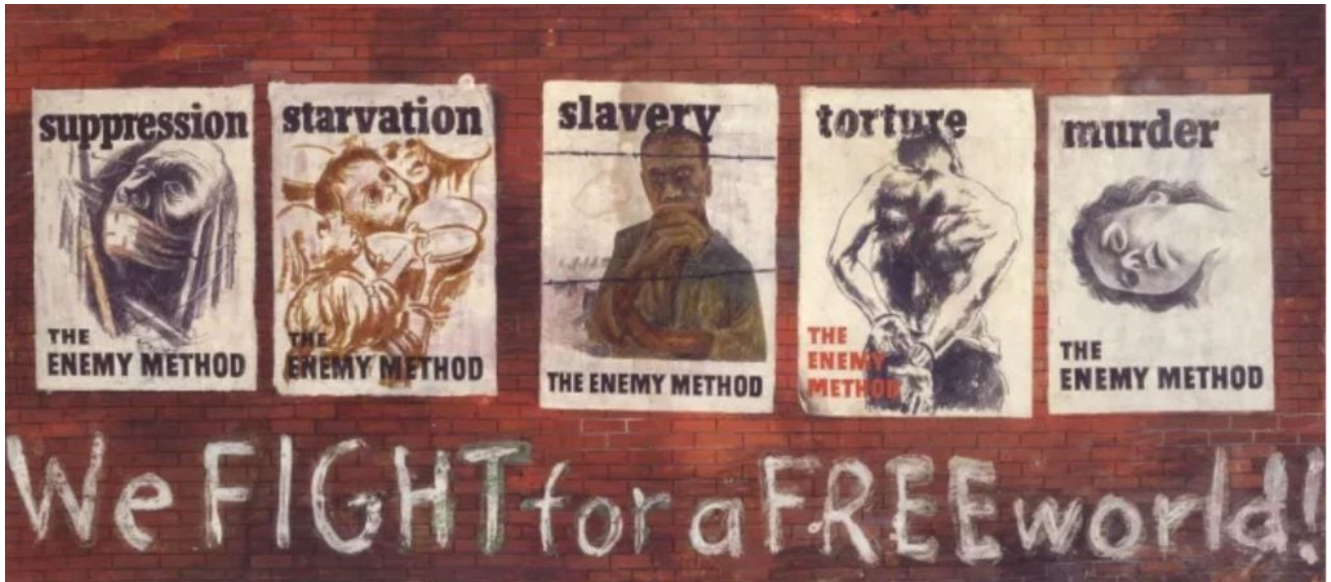


Busybodies Never Sleep

But back to the NGO Green Movement. The policymakers of these quangos (and there are millions of them in the West) demand enforcement of the right ways of thinking and chosen lifestyles, and punishment of the wrong ways of thinking and living.

Such unhappy, emotionally aggressive people who are 'woke' and oblivious to the suffering of others, also despise having fun and humour, especially satire (the lefty TV show hosts who tell unfunny PC jokes are responded with canned laughter. Catholic writer, Ann Barnhardt, said: "The broad populace is too far fallen morally and intellectually, and the oligarchs, and especially satan their master, knows it. They know that a massive percent of the population will believe pretty much *anything* anyone tells them."

The decadent West erupted in 1965, and just look at how morally inverted it has been evolving—especially over the past 25 years. (5:20)

But back to the busybody bureaucrats. The main culprits of this army of tyrannical do-gooders were summed-up quite well by C.S. Lewis, when he wrote: "Of all tyrannies, a tyranny exercised for the good of its victims may be the most oppressive. It may be better to live under robber barons than under omnipotent moral busybodies. The robber baron's cruelty may sometimes sleep, his cupidity may at some point be satiated; but those who torment us for our own good will torment us without end, for they do so with the approval of their own conscience. (*God in the Dock*, p. 292)."

Today, the busybodies in Lewis's quote seem to point to the Green\$ (*sic*...and morally sick), whose politicians and activists never sleep or leave us alone. They are always introducing policies that make us poorer and our lives harder, and have, over the past 15 years, caused untold misery, especially via taxation, to people in financial difficulties, as well as

destroying the aesthetic of the countryside with tens of thousands of ugly wind turbines. Then there are the draconian regulations that stifle small business, as well as banning some guilty pleasures that many of us occasionally enjoy.

In 2017, a league table of nanny state regulations put Britain at the number two spot as the second most meddlesome country in the EU, behind only Finland, a country with the highest rate of schizophrenia in the world. Finland now is one of the most heavily regulated countries in Europe, regarding drinks, food, alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes/vapes and much more. The findings were published by the Institute of Economic Affairs and the European Policy Information Centre. I would not be shocked if some Green zealots suggested putting dog cones around Finnish pooches necks to prevent them from eating chicken or red meat that fell on the floor during mealtimes.

But it is not just Finland: Ireland, France and America are not far behind, especially regarding the net-zero scourge of 'Climate Change,' leading to high rates, high taxation, and 'red tape,' something the current Irish Green Party leader, Eamon Ryan, who has recently announced his resignation, knows quite a lot about during his 10-year reign of busybody madness.

During the first wave of the so-called pandemic in March 2020 when Ireland was the biggest gulag in the world, Green Party leader Ryan stood up in the Dail (Parliament) and gave an impassioned speech about how people should start growing "salads" (lettuce) on their window sills in order to boost food reserves in case things got very bad.

He said: "Let's get every south-facing windowsill in this country and we'll plant our seeds in the next week so that if there is any supply crisis in food in two or three months' time when this really hits hard, *we'll have our salads ready to go!*" (I am not making this up.)

Worse: In October 2019 before this daft quote above, Ryan called for wolves to be reintroduced in Ireland almost 250 years after the species became extinct in the country. He said he believed that wolves should have a place in Ireland's environment and would contribute positively to the ecosystem and the State's national habitat. Really? The only positive contribution wolves would make for busybody politicians is the culling of chickens and other agri-livestock, which would prevent the rural Irish people of self-sustainment, thus dependent on government for food handouts.

And what about Irish residents who live in close proximity where many rural houses are merely a stone's throw away from one another? Ireland is not Alaska with vast tracts of uninhabited wilderness, where the odd cabin-dweller is hundreds of miles away from his nearest neighbour. The sight of roaming packs of wolves outside one's house in little Ireland could be a cunning lockdown tactic.

The Greens seem to love lockdowns and deserted roads and towns. And they are very concerned about endangered species, even slugs. It reminds me of a quote from the film, *A Man for All Seasons*, when the character Richard Rich tries to advance himself politically at any cost, by accepting the position of attorney-general for Wales by betraying his friend, Thomas More, who says: "For Wales? Why Richard, it profit a man nothing to give his soul for the whole world ... but for Wales!"? In the case of the Greens when they prioritise certain things instead of focusing on financially impoverished humans: " ...*But for snails?*

The good news is, their schemes have backfired, and now after four years in government, the Greens are back on the endangered species list. Even the hardest Leftists are sick and tired of them. In Ireland last month after a defeat in EU and local elections, Aontú Party leader, Peadar Kirby, said that the Green Party are the architects of their own downfall, and that the "stick" the party had used to change behaviour

was “now whipping them.”

They also use the “stick” in preventing SMEs from starting-up. In the USA, as in the EU, there are Green governmental polices, of which environmental regulations stifle many businesses and are not always about environmental protection.

According to environmental expert, Rich Trzupek, in his 2011 book, *Regulations Gone Wild*, in recent years, more than ever, regulations seem to have been designed by activists rather than scientists. Does this indicate that the Leftist Green movement and Big Nanny government have united to stifle productivity in the West and hamstringing innovation, not by design, but as the inevitable consequence of pursuing a utopian vision of environmental purity? Regulations gone wild, indeed.

Statista’s more recent findings (Feb 22, 2024) reveal that there are two-million NGOs in America. Not all of them stifle Mom-and-Pop businesses with red-tape regulations or interfere unnecessarily in the daily lives of ordinary people, but many of these State-funded psycho Mary Poppins’ clones-on-crack continue to torment the lives of normal people. And to think that we are nearly taxed out of existence to pay for the ‘privilege,’ while counting our every carbon footprint, as they lecture us with unpragmatic hogwash about the dangers of cows’ farts.

In the words of St Paul: “Besides, they get into the habit of being idle and going about from house to house. And not only do they become idlers, but also busybodies who talk nonsense, saying things they ought not to.” (1 Timothy 5:13)
