Asia Bibi, the Pakistani Christian woman who spent years on death row after being convicted of blasphemy, says she always believed she would be freed. Now whole world was praying for my misery to end. That made me feel that their <u>British</u> <u>government's refusal to offer her asylum</u> on the grounds that a certain community would be so disturbed that her safety couldn't be guaranteed.

Asia Bibi said on Friday that she had been invited to live in France, after a meeting with French President Emmanuel Macron. "I have received the invitation from the president and the French Republic, and I'm honored," she said.
