

'Liberals' in the United States blame 'white' man for Boulder shooting even as attacker turns out to be a Muslim immigrant

The brother of a Colorado man who shot and killed 10 people at a Boulder grocery store on Monday described his sibling as deeply disturbed. . . calling him "very anti-social" and paranoid.

He said his brother had previously been outgoing, but turned anti-social after he was subjected to bullying in high school. He does not believe his brother's attack was a political statement of any kind.

"[It was] not at all a political statement, it's mental illness," he said. "The guy used to get bullied a lot in high school . . . "



According to CNN, the family emigrated to the US from Syria in 2002.

Mr Alissa's brother said he was neither overtly political or religious, and that he was shocked by the killings.
