

MP shocked that 'anti-Muslim extremist' was invited to parliament

From [eventually reinstated back into the Labour party](#) after her suspension for racist and anti-semitic remarks. Jeremy Corbyn has so far always forgiven Labour activists called out for anti-semitism.
