## North Vancouver stabbing update expected from homicide investigators

From <u>stabbing in North Vancouver Saturday afternoon</u>, an attack police are calling "disturbing" and "heinous."

The victims were stabbed within and outside the Lynn Valley Library. First responders were called around 1:45 p.m. and encountered a chaotic scene. The Integrated Homicide Investigation Team has since been called in. Sgt. Frank Jang says one man is in custody, and that man has a criminal record.

"Obviously, the question is: Why did this happen? I understand

the what, the where, and the when. It is our job now to determ
ine the why," he says.



The i n suspect Saturday's attack had been identified as 28year-old Yannick Bandaogo, who police indicated had had dealings with the law previously. He's been charged with seconddegree murder and remains in custody. Vancouver Sun has a criminal record for offences of

violence in Quebec. My nasty suspicious mind pondered his possible origins based on his name. Yannick is a not uncommon
