"This has developed cross-party support, with Andy Burnham, Labour Mayor of Manchester, Tony Lloyd, Labour MP for Rochdale, and Christ Chapman, Conservative MP for neighbouring Heywood & Middleton, all calling for the three groomers to be returned to Pakistan. "

"Four years after their release from prison and two years after being stripped of their British citizenship, <u>news this</u> <u>evening</u> that he has taken his family abroad for their protection after an arson attack on a property owned by his wife (not the only threat he and his family have faced recently) and the new recent Covid 19 regulations will make it impossible for him to return and be available in time.
