Sex abuse trial: Youngsters used as 'play things'

Hassan-Sule, 20, of Glyndebourne Gardens, replied "no" when asked by defence barrister Michael Magarian QC whether he had sex with a complainant when she was 14.

Hassan-Sule said the girl was "manipulative" and there had been "no direct contact" between them.

Hassan-Sule admitted having sex with one 15-year-old girl, who later gave birth to his child, but only on one occasion when he thought she was 16.

The jury is expected to retire towards the end of next week.
