


Women in Literature Festival 2021

She is known as a feminist psychologist, and is the author of 19 books, including the best-seller *Women and Madness* (1972), *With Child: A Story of Motherhood* (1979) and *An American Bride in Kabul: A Memoir* (2013). Chesler has written on topics such as gender, mental illness, divorce and child custody, surrogacy, second-wave feminism, violence against women and more. Her most recent work *Requiem for a Serial Killer* was published in November 2020.
